Meeting Minutes, May 8, 2014

Carol called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

- Carol passed around April's minutes for approval. The minutes were motioned by Kathy and seconded by Carol, and were approved unanimously.

Reports/Updates

- Paula presented programs leading up to the Summer Learning Program (beginning June 1st)
 - Seussical Sing Along was March 21st. Nancy Stewart was the leader (cost \$275 for Nancy, plus \$75 for cookies), and generated a tremendous 103 attendees!
 - The bookswap program was held on April 1st. There were six tables filled, with 22 attendees. The plan is to repeat again in September.
 - The theme for this summer's kids program is Fizz Boom Read! Prizes for reading has been discontinued, but all participating kids will get a notebook and reading log. Those who complete the program will get their name in the drawing for a Kindle Fire.
 - Summer programs funded by KCLS include: Eli Rosenblatt (music); LivePaint; Build a robot puppet; Rocket eruptions; Kitchen science.
 - Summer programs funded by DFOL include: Stuffy Sleepover and Stuffy Brunch (\$as food costs); Tad & Fry puppet show (\$350); Insect Safari (\$250); Planet of the Amps Concert (\$350).
- Kirsten presented the Teens Summer program:
 - Spark a Reaction – participants receive a free flashdrive if they either complete all activities or read for 12 hours.
 - Writing contest (started earlier this year), where there is a \$25 prize, a \$15 prize, and ~\$35 in miscellaneous prizes.
 - June – zombie writing workshop, with Katherine Grace Bond
 - July 12th – Power of Zines (\$100 from DFOL)
 - July 29th – Batman Day (DFOL funds \$50 pizza)
 - July 29th – Game On (DFOL funds \$50 pizza)
 - August 16th – Animania/Tosho Con III (in Carnation) (\$200 from DFOL). Note: Dealers Room is open 11am – 4pm, and need DFOL members to supervise/run event.
 - August 19th – Candy Experiments workshop (\$250 from DFOL)
 - Wilderness Awareness is sponsoring Wilderness Adventures on 7/8, 7/10, and 7/15
- Irene announced that we have Portable Art displays up at the library, where we are partnering with NW Arts Center (5/9 – 5/31). This cost is also shared with KCLS.
 - For Duvall Days, the Book Van will be in the library parking lot; a table/booth will be set up in front of the library; participants in the parade need to meet at the library at 9am.
 - The Library Service Plan is commencing – this is a 20 week study of community, utilizing tools such as SimpleMap and CommunityConnect. The purpose is to analyze how to get people who don't use the library to participate in programs. This is cluster-wide.
 - The library will participate in the Duvall Heritage Festival – theme is Plein Air. This is the last weekend of Sept.
 - Beginning the last Monday of June, through the last Monday of August (week A), the van will be in town to take around to daycares and the community. We get approximately every 3 weeks. The van will also go to 2 camps – Cottage Lake/Northshore YMCA camps, exposing several hundred kids during the summer.
- Jill stated the Library Board is getting flyers out, including inclusion in the City of Duvall utility billings, as monthly topics that will also be posted to the website.

New Business

- Raffle Barrel:
 - The Civics Club 46th Annual Plant and Garden Sale is May 10th, from 10am-4pm.
 - Carol has a volunteer shift schedule; Jill stated that Library Board members are volunteering time at the DFOL booth/raffle ticket table
 - Jill agreed to transport the barrel from the library to the Rose room on Friday, May 9th (with tent and tablecloth too)
- Planning an Author Event with Local Authors
 - We discussed multiple ideas/opportunities to have an author event (or series of events), which could be Friday night events, and finally leading up to a full-day program (possibly April/May 2015)
 - Who is the target audience? Duvall Write, Poetry Group, multiple local authors
