Meeting Minutes, June 11, 2015

Carol called the meeting to order at 7:02pm

- Carol passed around May's minutes for approval. Linda moved to approve the amended minutes, Darlene seconded, and were approved unanimously.

Reports/Updates

- Mary reported:
 - KCLS has created a "matchbook style" customized book list. It is available to order on the website, where the librarian will create the book list based upon interests.
 - The Redmond library (in our cluster) is included in the 2014 Year in Review
 - In May, there were 50 attendees in the Early Literacy session, 26 in the English Language story time, 26 in Children's Literacy program, 16 in Teen programs, 4 in Adult Literacy program, 22 in Talk Time. There were 48 new patron registrations.
 - 50 people attended the May 21st Sing with Charlie Hope program.
 - Summer programs include music programs, Legos, puppets, live paint, magic, and others – under the theme Mind Matters. (Note: DFOL is sponsoring Writing Memoirs on June 16th.)
- Duvall Days is on June 6th.

New Business

- Stephanie shared the Treasurer report. Cash as of May 31st was \$18,677. During May, we had \$126 in book sales, \$530 in pledge donations, and \$231 for the raffle. Note: the raffle generated \$738 in donations. \$454 was spent on Children's programs and \$160 in adult programs.
- The board approved paying for \$75 to the Duvall Chamber of Commerce.
- The board agreed to continue meetings on the second Thursday of each month for 2015-2016; Mary will book the room.
- Carol stated that Jeff Kempe is talking to Movie License USA in order to obtain a license to show movies in the library.

Future meetings/dates

- June 13th: Duvall Reads *A Tale for the Time Being* by Ruth Ozeki
- DFOL and Duvall Reads breaks for the summer, returning in September
