Meeting Minutes, September 10, 2015

Carol called the meeting to order at 7:01pm

- Carol passed around June's minutes for approval. Darlene moved to approve the amended minutes, Linda seconded, and were approved unanimously.
- We welcomed our guest, Joyce Ward, who is considering membership

#### Reports/Updates

- Mary reported:
  - Our movie license has been granted. 3 movies have been scheduled so far, and shades have been ordered. There needs to be a responsible adult in the room at all times – librarian staff will cycle each 30 minutes. October 2<sup>nd</sup> is "Up" and November 14<sup>th</sup> is "Humanity's Future in Space". Monthly movies are proposed throughout 2016.
  - Mushroom Hunting in the Northwest was well attended (full room) on Sep 3<sup>rd</sup>.
  - Throughout July and August, there were 114 attendees in the Early Literacy session, 158 in the English Language story time, 177 in Children's programs, 273 in Teen programs, 30 in Adult Literacy program. There were 74 new patron registrations.
  - The library will be participating in the 9/24 Farmer's Market – Terry Irish will present a session on preserving greens that have been growing in your garden at 4pm.
  - September programs include story times and Animania! Bring a Friend Day.
  - There is a Community Discovery Day at the Redmond library on the first Wednesday of each month, 3-5pm, which partners with 15 +/- agencies.

#### New Business

- On Stephanie's behalf, Michele shared the Treasurer report. Cash as of July 31<sup>st</sup> was \$18,051. During July, we had \$666 in book sales and \$83 in donations. \$150 was spent on Adult programs and \$50 in Teen programs, plus \$100 for gift cards/staff appreciation.
- We will be establishing new pricing for children's books (10c); Linda will send an email to Mary to coordinate with KCLS graphics for a new sign. The children's books are now located on the new display shelves.
- On October 10<sup>th</sup> the Duvall Chamber of Commerce is hosting an event: "Get Involved, Duvall". Multiple local organizations will participate, presenting opportunities for residents to get involved. DFOL will share the library's table.
- We discussed sending some books to the Monroe penitentiary – Linda will research further.

- Friends of Youth has requested us to be a sponsor for their annual event – we will contribute \$250, which provides a sign on the podium, posters, website, plus notice on the presentation screen.
- Sno Valley community network sent a thank-you for our sponsorship of their Power of Possibility speaker at the Key Leaders Summit (8/10/15).
